 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - b. Note: pick either class B or C, not both**
- C. Purebred Bred & Owned Yearling Female, born on or after Jan 1, 2007
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - b. Exhibitor must be breeder & present owner of entry as verifiable on the CSA registration paper**
 - c. Note: pick either class B or C, not both**
- B. Purebred 2 yr Old Female, born on or after Jan. 1, 2006
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - b. Natural 2008 registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood calf must be shown at side
- C. Purebred Mature Female, born on or before Dec. 31,2005
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental female
 - b. Natural 2008 registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood calf must be shown at side
- D. Purebred Bull Calf, born on or after Jan.1, 2008
 - a. Registered/tattooed purebred or fullblood Simmental male
- E. Commercial Heifer Calf, born on or after Jan. 1, 2008
 - a. Crossbred/Percentage Simmental Female or CSA Recorded percentage female
 - b. Entry must display Simmental characteristics
- F. Commercial Yearling Female, born on or after Jan. 1, 2007
 - a. Crossbred/Percentage Simmental Female or CSA Recorded percentage female
 - b. Entry must display Simmental characteristics
- G. Commercial 2 yr Old Female, born on or after Jan 1, 2006

YCSA Membership is a one time fee of \$26.75. This entitles the member to a complimentary subscription to the Simmental Country until their 26th birthday, and the right to register cattle in your own name. Once your YCSA membership has expired, the fee can be deducted from a lifetime membership. YCSA Memberships allow persons greater access to a number of available scholarship opportunities.

YCSA Rules: a complete set of Rules can be found at www.simmental.com or mailed to you by request.

- Participants in Regional Classics are not required to hold an individual YCSA membership. Membership is encouraged.
- Participants in the National Classic are required to hold an individual YCSA membership.
- Participants must be 25 years and younger as of January 1st of the competition year.
- Contestants must compete in Judging, Herdsman Quiz and Sire Summary Quiz at the scheduled competition time to be eligible for Showmanship and Conformation Classes.
- Ties will be broken by comparing scores in the following events.
 - 1st Tie-breaker = Sire Summary
 - 2nd Tie-breaker = Herdsman Quiz
 - 3rd Tie-breaker = Judging Contest.
- Novice, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior division eligibility.
 - Novice: 10 years and under as of January 1st of the competition year.
 - Junior: 11-14 years as of January 1st of the competition year.
 - Intermediate: 15-17 as of January 1st of the competition year.
 - Senior: 18-25 as of January 1st of the competition year.
- Conduct:
 - All competitors in attendance of Classics are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and respect.
 - Violations include, but are not limited to: misrepresentation of animals, vandalism, theft, fighting, unsportsmanlike conduct, failure to comply with directives of officials, being in possession of or under the influence of **alcohol** or

other prohibited substances while on the **competition grounds** and/or in **public areas.**

- Violations of these standards will result in immediate review by the Hearing Committee.
- No artificial filling of animals will be allowed unless under the advice of a licensed, non-owner, veterinarian. Violation will result in immediate review by the Hearing Committee.
 - All livestock entries must be stalled by the published move-in time on the published move-in date. Livestock release follows the awards ceremony.
 - Ownership Rules
 - All entries in the **Bred & Owned** division must be registered as such under the entrants' name. A copy of the CSA registration paper must be provided during event registration.
 - All entries, excluding Bred & Owned, must be **registered to the entrant, entrants immediate family or entrants immediate family farm, or registered as a 4H project of the entrant.** A copy of the CSA registration paper or 4H certificate must be provided during event registration.
