The organizing committee and Quadrant Australia shall not be liable for individual arrangements made by Congress participants outside the organized Congress programme. All international participants will require a current passport for entry to Australia. It is the responsibility of the participant to hold current and correct documentation and entry Visas to Australia. Please check with your closest Australian High Commission or Embassy to ascertain if you need an entry Visa. The Firm accepts no responsibility for any passenger that arrives in Australia without the correct Visa documentation.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

We highly recommend Travel insurance to cover unforeseen circumstances. Please check with your insurance provider.

DEPOSITS AND FINAL PAYMENT

An initial deposit is payable at the time of registration. Final payment is due on or before 15 June 2010. If you register after 15 June 2010 all endeavours will be made to book appropriate services, if available, and full and final payment is required at the time of registering. It is a condition of the acceptance of your payment in respect of this programme that all monies paid by you to Quadrant Australia whether by way of deposit or otherwise in respect of the tour, may be disbursed by Quadrant Australia as and when it sees fit or in respect of the services to be provided or fees payable under the programme, and the payment of a deposit, shall be deemed to be a direction by you to Quadrant Australia to disburse such monies as stated. CANCELLATIONS

All cancellations must be advised in writing. a) Pre and Post Congress Tours: Cancellation of Pre and Post Congress Tours prior to 15 February 2010 will incur an Administration Fee of \$150.00. Cancellations received after 15 February and before 15 April 2010, will receive a refund of monies paid less an administration fee of AUD \$250.00. Cancellations from 15 April 2010 to 15 June 2010 will receive a refund less a fee of AUD \$500.00. Cancellation after 15 June 2010, no refund. b) Congress Registration: Cancellation of Congress registration prior to 15 February will incur a fee of AUD \$100.00. Cancellations received after 15 February 2010 and before 15 April 2010 will receive refund of monies paid less a fee of AUD \$150.00. Cancellations received from 15 April to 15 June 2010, will receive a refund of registration less a fee of AUD \$300.00. No refunds will be provided after 15 June 2010. Substitution of delegates may be permitted with written approval of Congress Committee.

UNUSED SERVICES
